

## Skin Integrity Risk Plans of Care

### Quick reference guide

The *Risk of Skin Integrity Plan of Care* is a multi-phase, goal and intervention driven tool which supports the ongoing assessment and comprehensive documentation of pressure injuries and other wound care

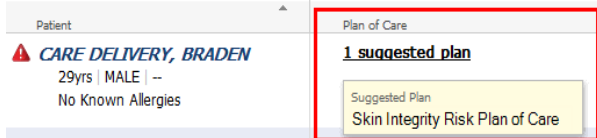




Upon completing the admission rule tasks, patients identified as having a pressure injury and patients who are at risk will have the *Skin Integrity Risk Plan of Care* suggested. The suggested Plan of Care must be accepted, and the appropriate phase(s) is to be initiated.

### Initiating the suggested Skin Integrity Risk Plan of Care



Suggested POC's appear on *CareCompass* and the *Orders* Page

1. Click on the suggested plan on *CareCompass*, this will open the orders page

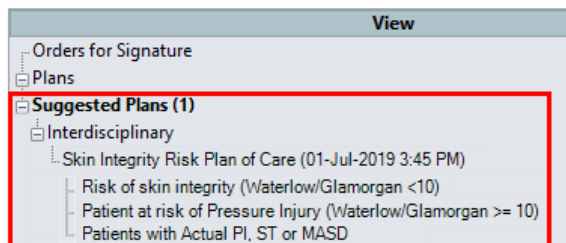


2. Expand the 'Suggested Plans' by clicking the expand , select the *Skin Integrity Risk Plan of Care* and click 





3. Review the phases and select the appropriate phase for the patient

### Documenting against the Skin Integrity Risk Plan of Care

1. From the *Orders* screen, click the *document in plan* button

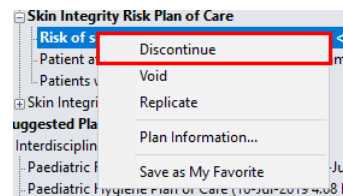
2. Select the *Skin Integrity Risk Plan of Care*

4. Once the documentation against the assessment is completed, click *Sign* 


5. Click *Refresh* 


### Commencing a new Phase in the POC

A patient may require the commencement/upgrade to a new phase due to an increased risk. To commence a new phase

1. Right click on the current phase and select *Discontinue*



2. Select  to discontinue all orders, interventions and goals in the POC

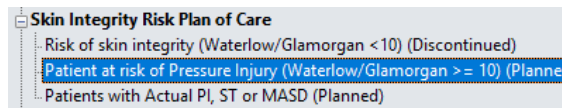
3. Review the discontinued orders, complete missing details and click 

4. Click 

5. Click *Refresh* 

The phase has now been discontinued

6. Select the new phase to be initiated in the POC



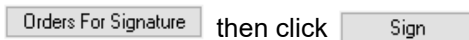

### Discontinuing the Skin Integrity Risk Plan of Care

1. From the *Orders* screen, right-click on the *Skin Integrity Risk Plan of Care* and select *Discontinue*

A pop-up window will appear with active orders that are attached to the POC.

2. Review the orders to ensure that all orders are appropriate to be discontinued. Should an order be appropriate to remain place a tick in the keep column. Click *OK*

3. Click *Sign* ✓ to confirm the discontinue action.
